



Whereas by an Indenture bearing even date herewith and made between Francis Thomas Cudon of 5 Gray's Inn Square in the County of Middlesex Gentleman of the first part John Augustus Beaumont of N<sup>o</sup> 81 Lancaster Gate in the same County Esquire of the second part me the undersigned John Gurney herein described as of Sprowston in the County of Norfolk Esquire of the third part and Francis Gostling Foster of the City of Norwich Gentleman of the fourth part All and singular the Capital and other Messuages Park farms lands tenements and Tithes Commutation Rent charge of him the said John Augustus Beaumont mentioned and comprised in the Schedule to the said Indenture and which said Hereditaments are situate lying and being in the parishes of Wimbledon and Wandsworth in the County of Surrey and contain altogether Eight hundred and seventeen acres three roods and three perches or thereabouts were conveyed and assured unto and to the use of me the said John Gurney my heirs and assigns as and by way of Mortgage for securing to me my executors administrators and assigns the payment of the sum of Fifty one thousand pounds with interest for the same after the rate of Five pounds and ten shillings per centum per annum reducible to Four pounds and ten shillings per centum as in the said Indenture mentioned And whereas in point of fact the sum of Thirty five thousand pounds part of the said sum of Fifty one thousand pounds belongs to and is the proper money of John Henry Gurney of Martdon in the County of Devon Esquire Samuel Gurney of 20 Hanover Terrace Regents Park in the County of Middlesex Esquire and Henry Edmund Gurney of Nutwood in the County of Surrey Esquire jointly on a joint account Now I the said John Gurney do hereby admit and acknowledge that the sum of Thirty five thousand pounds part of the said sum of Fifty one thousand

pounds belongs to and is the proper money  
of the said John Henry Gurney Samuel Gurney  
and Henry Edmund Gurney jointly on a joint  
account and that I hold the said sum of fifty one thousand  
pounds and its interest and all securities for the same  
as to the said sum of thirty five thousand pounds and its  
interest upon trust for the said John Henry Gurney Samuel  
Gurney and Henry Edmund Gurney their executors administrators  
and assigns absolutely and whereas the said John Henry  
Gurney Samuel Gurney and Henry Edmund Gurney have  
advanced the said sum of thirty five thousand pounds  
on the above security at my request and upon condition  
that I should give them the indemnity hereinafter contained  
Now I the said John Gurney do hereby for myself my heirs  
executors and administrators agree to indemnify the said  
John Henry Gurney Samuel Gurney and Henry Edmund  
Gurney their executors administrators and assigns from  
all loss of what kind soever which shall or may accrue to  
them or any of them by reason of their having advanced  
the said sum of thirty five thousand pounds on the above  
security or otherwise in relation thereto O WITNES my hand  
this second day of May one thousand eight hundred  
and seventy two.
